

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)

Directive 2012/19/EU

Directive 2012/19/EU, commonly called the WEEE Directive, is a European Union law that governs the collection, treatment, recycling, and recovery of waste electrical and electronic equipment. It establishes producer responsibility across EU member states and is a central part of the EU's broader approach to reducing electronic waste and promoting a circular economy.

SV Microwave manufactures passive RF components and interconnect products that are intended for incorporation into larger electrical and electronic equipment and are not Electrical or Electronic Equipment (EEE) in their own right. Accordingly, these products are generally outside the scope of the WEEE Directive. Products incorporating independent electrical or electronic functionality are evaluated separately for WEEE applicability.
